Welcome to Neighbourhood Angels

What is Neighbourhood Angels?

Neighbourhood Angels is a volunteer-based befriending project in Guildford Borough. This is a new project, funded by Guildford Borough Council and managed by the Church of England.

Who is Neighbourhood Angels for?

Any adult in the Borough of Guildford who is experiencing isolation or loneliness, particularly those who live alone. This may include adults who are bereaved, lack confidence, have limited transport or lack family and community support. There is no age restriction because anyone can experience isolation.



Who are Neighbourhood Angels?

Neighbourhood Angels are volunteers who have been trained, interviewed and police-checked. They can offer friendship, support and information about your local community. They do not provide personal care, medical care or housework.



How does Neighbourhood Angels work?

Step 1: First Visit

Rachel, the project co-ordinator, will visit you to check if the project will suit your needs and that you are happy to go ahead.

Step 2: Connecting with a Neighbourhood Angel

You will be matched with an appropriate volunteer as soon as possible, who may have similar interests to you and live locally. The same volunteer will visit you at a time that suits you on a regular basis.



Step 3: Connecting with the Community

The volunteer will talk to you about what interests you and may suggest groups in your community which they will visit with you.



Step 4: Onwards and Upwards....

After an certain amount of time, (perhaps around 6 months), you may feel you have benefitted fully from the project and no longer require the support from a Neighbourhood Angel. However, the time scale is flexible because we appreciate everyone is different.
