of our firing line at a point about 250' from the
 enemy's advanced trench where the enclosure was
 terminated by a short cross bank.
 At this point the advance was delayed for the bridging
 operations and during this delay the Commanding
 officer was wounded and shortly after the Adjutant
 was killed. Major STILLWELL then assumed command.
 It was found impossible to throw the barge across
 the mouth of the MEENINAH creek as the SUMANA's
 — engines were disabled by shell fire before the
 barges stern could be brought in to the bank.
 During this operation No 3 Coy suffered severely from
 shell and rifle fire.
 The 4th Pioneers & sappers & miners then succeeded in
 erecting two single plank trestle bridges and when they
 were in position Major McLeod of 2nd Gurkhas
 (commanding the firing line) ordered the advance.
 The creek was after all found to be fordable and
 the line formed up and fixed bayonets under cover
 of the N bank.
