Informant states that on 13th July 1916 at Trones Wood, Capt. Bennett was shot in the head and died shortly afterwards. This happened about 150 yards in front of the British trenches. Further details could be obtained from Pte Courtman of the same company who was Capt. Bennett's servant. He went to him as soon as he was wounded and tried to bandage him and stayed with him until he was wounded himself. Courtman came to England in a hospital boat on 19th July but Informant does not know what hospital he went to. His home is at Beddington, nr. Croydon. Informant does not know his number.
