- **Burglary** – when out of your house in the evenings, make sure it is secured properly and looks occupied.
- **Anti-social behaviour** – be aware of how your actions may impact other people, especially those who are elderly or vulnerable. Make sure to report offences to the right agency whether it is the police or council.
- **Fraud and cyber-crime** – be observant when online shopping for Black Friday or Christmas presents, and report any suspicious sites to Action Fraud UK. If it looks too good to be true, it probably is!
