## **Our Proposal**

Horseshoe Lane West, Whitehouse Drive, Greencroft, Beechway and Holmesdale Close would become a School Street zone at set times in the morning and afternoon. During these set times only vehicles that have been granted an exemption will be permitted to enter this road. Signs to inform drivers of the restrictions would be installed at the entrance to the road.

## **Times of operation for the School Street**

The proposed operating times for St Thomas of Canterbury Catholic Primary School are 8-9am and 2.30-3.45pm, Monday to Friday, term-time only. School Streets do not operate during school holidays or at weekends.

## **Enforcement**

An Automatic Number Plate Recognition (ANPR) camera will be installed on the street to check the vehicles that enter and exit during the period of operation. Vehicles entering the School Street during its operational hours without a registered exemption will receive a penalty charge notice (PCN).



### **Enforcement continued**

For the first 6 months of operation a letter of warning will be issued to non-exempt vehicles entering the School Street zone during times of operation, if they repeat the offence a second time a penalty notice of £70 will be issued (£35 if paid within 21 days).
